Today is Anna bhau Sathe Birth Anniversary 2022 of Anna Bhau Sathe i.e. Tukaram Bhaurao Sathe who has many titles like the social reformer, folk poet, writer, and Shaheer. Anna bhau Sathe was born on August 1, 1920, in Wategaon village of Walwa taluka of Sangli district. He did social enlightenment for the underprivileged throughout his life by making Shahiri in a rural language that could be easily understood by common people. Due to the caste system and poverty, he could not get an education, but Anna bhau took a big leap in the field of literature. His writings were based on social and political activism. His contribution was very valuable to the United Maharashtra Movement. He expressed the hope that the name of Maharashtra should be engraved in the world by creating a progressive-thinking Maharashtra. The voice was raised against the slavery of Dalits. Anna bhau's specialty is writing on the pains of the poor, farmers, farm laborers, and laborers. That is why Anna bhau Sathe's literature has become a direction and a catalyst for change.

Lokmanya Bal Gangadhar Tilak (Lokmanya Tilak) was a great Indian leader and modern commentator of the Bhagavad Gita. He was born in Ratnagiri. His birth name was Keshav but the name Bal later became popular. Bal Gangadhar Tilak was an Indian freedom fighter, teacher, editor, and writer. He is referred to as 'Lokmanya'. Although his real name was Keshav, everyone knew him by the nickname 'Baal'. His father Gangadhar Ramachandra Tilak was a famous teacher and Sanskrit scholar. Tilak was a brilliant student from his childhood and was particularly gifted in mathematics.

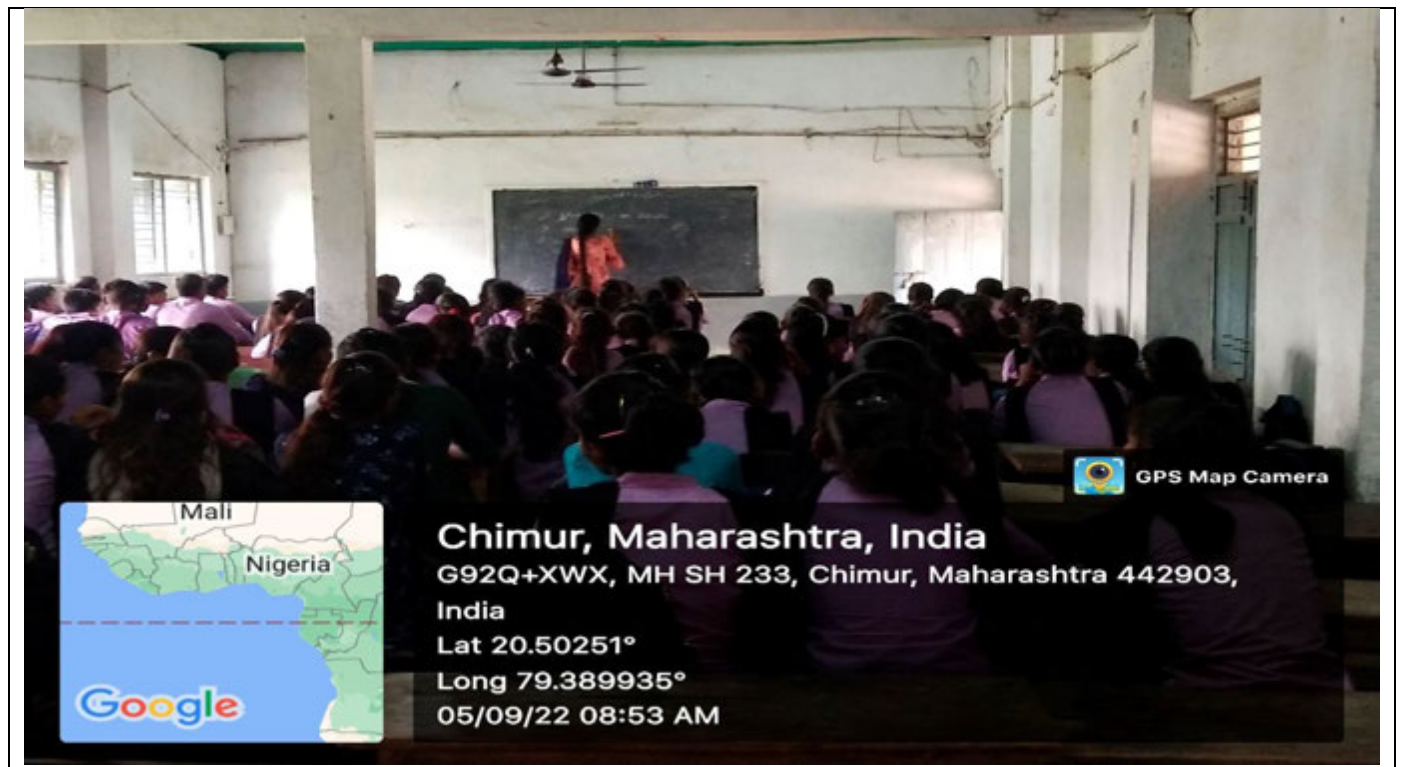


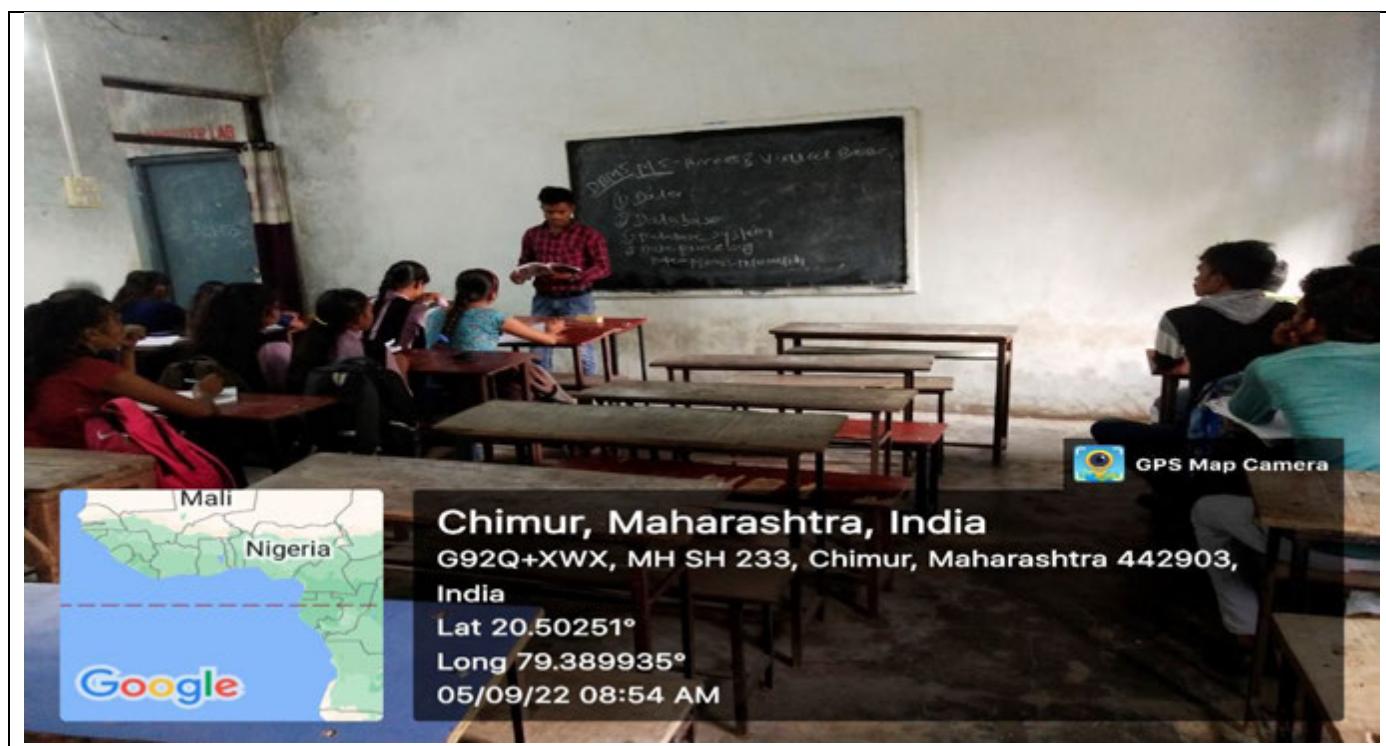
